

Overlapping Circles Project

Materials needed:

Lined or plain white paper
A pencil or pen
A set of colored pencils, thin markers, or crayons
A ruler or straightedge (optional)
A roll of masking tape

Directions:

1. Use your pen or pencil to trace the inside circle of your masking tape roll in overlapping patterns that fill the paper.
2. Use your ruler or straightedge to trace lines over the blue lines if you're using lined paper and decide on a color scheme and a pattern (see my example in the video). Then fill in and shade the lines according to the pattern you chose.
3. Repeat step 2 for every single overlapping shape on your page until you finish. You can switch up your color scheme at any time. There are no hard and fast rules to this at all, and you can't mess it up! Be as creative as you'd like :)
